Circular Letter No. 00-1344

RE: NCCI ITEM B-1363 — Codes 7403, 7405, 7423, & 7431 – Air Carrier Classification – Amended Phraseologies

The Minnesota Department of Commerce has approved the above filing to be effective 12:01 a.m., July 1, 2000, applicable to new and renewal business only.

The purpose of the above numbered filing is to amend selected classification phraseologies in the *Basic Manual* to reflect changes in the Federal Aviation Regulations (F.A.R.). Previously all aircraft operated by air carriers with seating for 30 or fewer passengers were subject to F.A.R. 135. Due to changes in these regulations, many of those aircraft are now subject to the more stringent safety rules found in F.A.R. 121. Since the classification approach for the aircraft industry tracks the applicable federal aviation regulations, it is necessary to amend the affected classifications to keep them in line with their original intent.

The attached exhibit illustrates the changes to the *Basic Manual* necessary to implement the amended phraseologies affecting the footnotes of Codes 7403, 7405, 7423, and 7431. Association staff anticipates that this filing will have no impact on current premium levels in Minnesota. Please note that the proposed language on the exhibit pages contains underlined and strikethrough text. The underlining represents new or added text while the strikethroughs indicate deleted text.
