RE: Discontinuing PEEP- Policy Entry and Edit Package

For your review, attached is an announcement from the Compensation Data Exchange, LLC (CDX) dated October 17, 2012, stating that CDX has decided that the Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) will no longer be available after December 31, 2014, because the program is cost prohibitive to maintain. Other CDX products are not impacted by this change.

The CDX announcement mentions that some Data Collection Organizations (DCOs) have already developed a PEEP replacement product. In 2011, Minnesota Workers' Compensation Insurers Association, Inc. (MWCIA) released the Minnesota Manage Policy System (MPS). MPS allows member carriers to manage their own policy data. Features of the system include: functions to import, create, and submit electronic policy transactions; comprehensive transaction validation; near-time electronic submission processing by the MWCIA; robust transaction and coverage search capabilities; and over thirty-three months of coverage and transaction history.

RE: PEEP – Policy Entry and Edit Package

Attention: CDX PEEP Users

CDX has decided that Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) will no longer be available after December 31, 2014, because the program is cost prohibitive to maintain. E ach Data Collection Organization (DCO) will independently determine if they will build a replacement product. Some DCOs have already developed such a product. It is recommended that you contact individual DCOs as necessary with any questions, concerns, or to obtain additional information. Each DCO will advise the industry as it determines its course of action.

Please note that only PEEP is being discontinued. This will have no impact on other CDX products such as Bureau Entry and E dit Package (BEEP). Direct file transfer of WCPOLS files through CDX will also be unaffected.
