RE: Rollout for ARROW Enhancements

On December 9, 2013, the Minnesota Workers' Compensation Insurers Association, Inc. (MWCIA) will release the latest enhancements to the Actuarial Report Resource on the Web (ARROW) product.

The most significant enhancement for member carriers will be the integration of ARROW into the MWCIA Web Membership system. The login and password credentials that are currently used to access carrier-specific queries in ARROW will no longer be valid. If member carriers want to access their own statistical plan data via ARROW on or after December 9, 2013, they must assign permissions for their users through Web Membership.

Note that the public will continue to have access to the statewide queries available within the ARROW product, which is located under the Carriers/Agents menu on www.mwcia.org.
