RE: Clarification on Expired Class Codes Related to NCCI Item – B-1435 – Revisions to Basic Manual Classifications and Appendix E – Classification by Hazard Group, Including Trucking and Towing

On May, 18, 2017, MWCIA distributed Circular Letter No. 17-1710 announcing that the Minnesota Department of Commerce had approved NCCI Item B-1435 filing, as referenced above. Part of this filing involved the elimination of class codes 7228 and 7229 and reassigning their exposure to newly established class codes 7219 and 7225, effective January 1, 2018.

MWCIA wants to clarify that policies effective January 1, 2018 and thereafter, containing class codes 7228 or 7229 will not be rejected by our database but error messages will be generated to let carriers know that these two class codes are expired codes in the state of Minnesota.

It is important to understand that when submitting Unit Statistical Reports, carriers need to make sure that the new class codes 7219 and 7225 are used, as Unit Statistical Reports containing invalid class codes 7228 and 7229 will be rejected by MWCIA.

Carriers choosing to use class codes 7219 or 7225 after January 1, 2018, will need to make a rate filing with the Minnesota Department of Commerce by December 31, 2018 using the 1-1-2018 MWCIA Loss Costs.
